

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING – Monday, December 16, 2013

The Cambridge City Council met in special session on Monday, December 16, 2013, at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall with the following council members present: Macki, Kovarik, Mayor DeYoung, Mortensen, Taylor, Thom. Absent: None. Visitors: Barb McBreen, Whitney Sager, Steve Russell.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor DeYoung at 6:00 p.m.

Steve Russell addressed the council concerning the open dumping violation notices he had received for his properties at 102 S. Water Street and 217 S. Sycamore Street. He informed the council of the clean-up he had done at both properties and his plans for the remainder. Mayor DeYoung stated that he had met the requirements of the notices, and the council thanked him for complying. A motion by Macki, seconded by Thom, to close the hearing. Roll Call: All Ayes.

The next agenda item was the public hearing to consider amendment of the city zoning code. No comments were brought forward by citizens in attendance, and no written comments were received prior to the hearing. A motion by Macki, seconded by Kovarik, to close the public hearing. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Ordinance No. 13-C, "An Ordinance Amending The Code Of Ordinances Of The City Of Cambridge, Iowa, By Adding A New Section Identifying And Adding A Zoning District," was presented to the council on its final reading. A motion by Thom, seconded by Kovarik, was made to approve the zoning amendment. Roll Call: Ayes: Kovarik, Macki, Mortensen, Taylor, Thom. Nays: None. Motion carried.

The last agenda item concerned the update of the city code. Macki wanted to say that he appreciated the efforts of Thom and Mortensen on coordinating the update. The council reviewed the second draft of the code and agreed to begin the process of adopting it. The scheduled the first reading of the ordinance to adopt the new code at the January regular council meeting.

A motion by Macki, seconded by Thom, to adjourn the meeting. Roll Call: All Ayes. The meeting was adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
